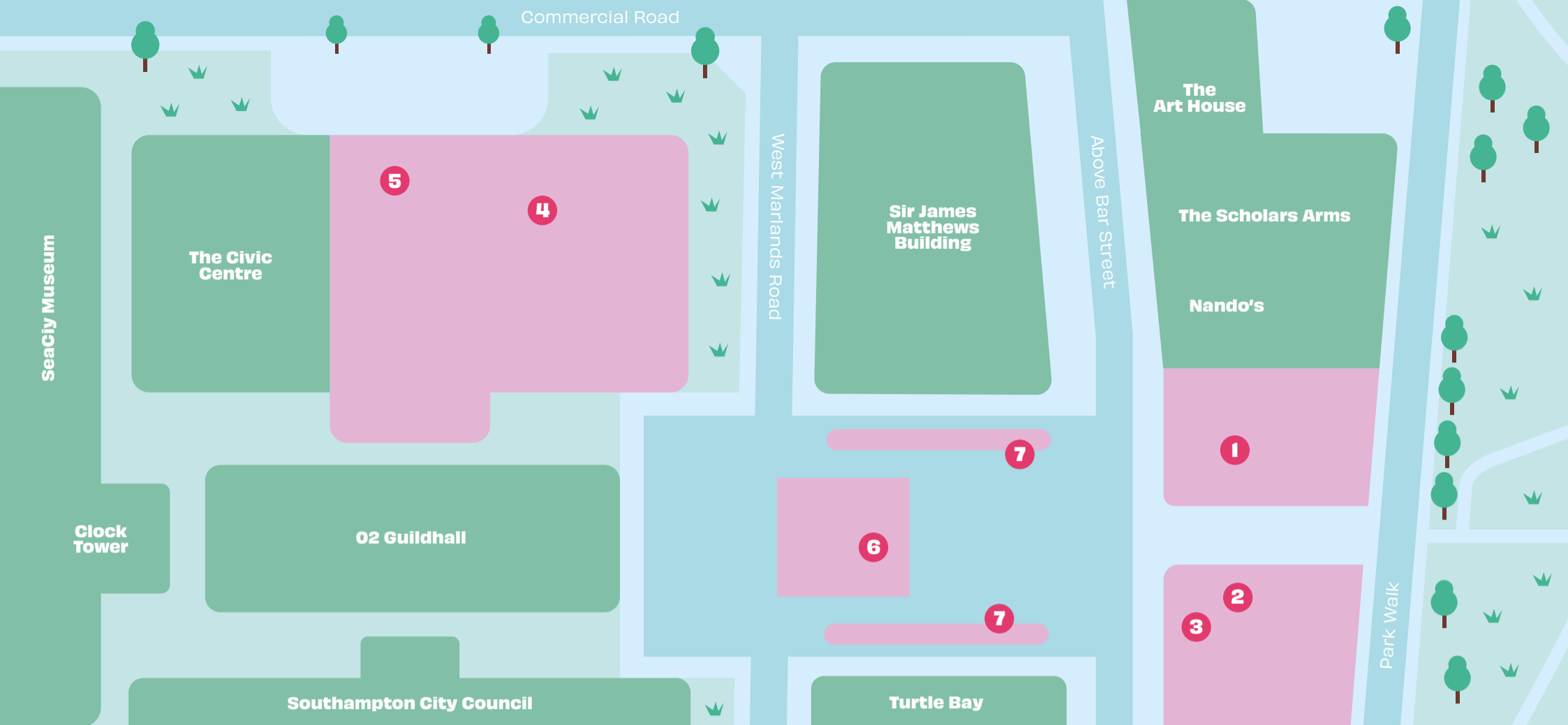

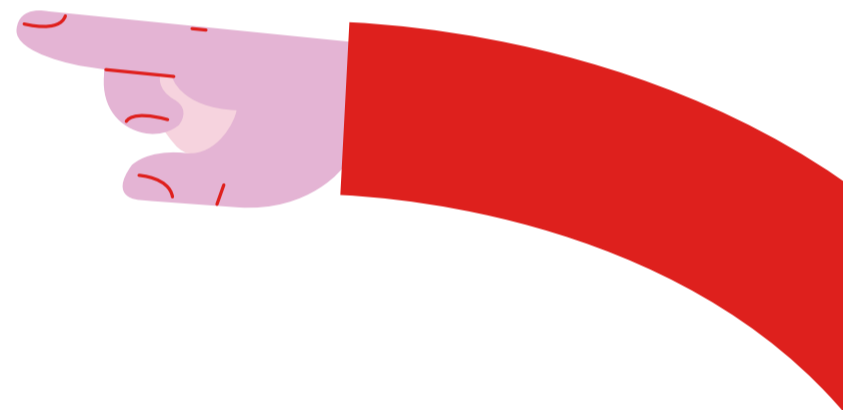

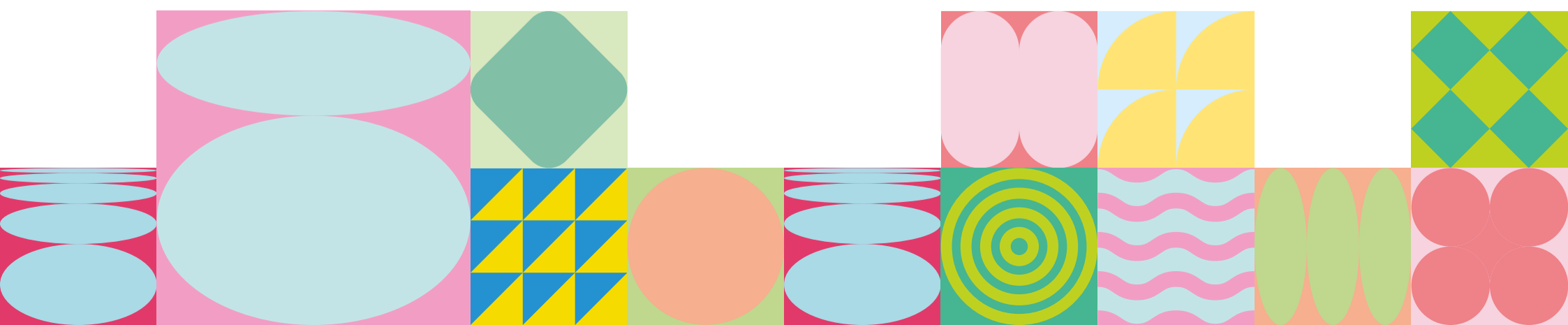
Southampton City Art Gallery 10am

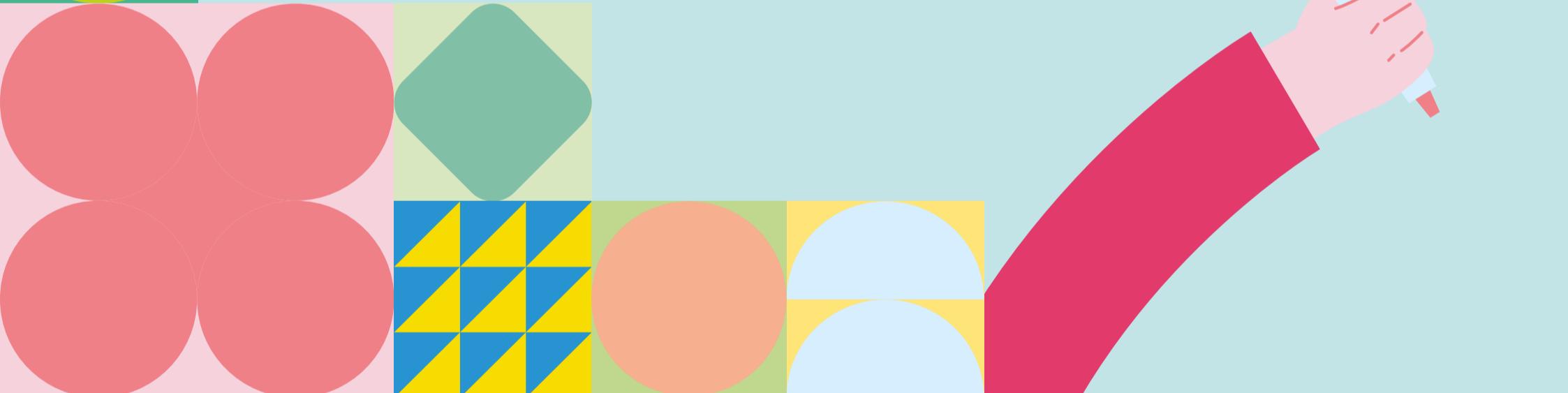
